Chemistry profile and complete blood count (CBC)

A comprehensive blood chemistry profile, including SDMA, provides information about your dog's kidneys, liver, and pancreas, as well as other functions of the body, such as blood sugar and hydration. A CBC can identify infection. inflammation, and anemia.

Infectious disease screening

This screening identifies whether your dog has been exposed to parasitic diseases, such as tick-borne diseases, heartworm, or other infectious diseases.

Fecal test

This test checks for intestinal parasites that may live in your dog's gastrointestinal tract. Since they are usually hidden from view, the only way to detect and identify most intestinal parasites is by doing a fecal test.

Thyroid function test

A thyroid function test detects whether or not your dog's thyroid gland is functioning properly. Thyroid disease is very common in older dogs.

Complete urinalysis

This analysis assesses the overall health of your dog's urinary tract, including the kidneys and bladder. It identifies infection or inflammation in the urinary tract.

Radiographs

Preventive radiography imaging exams are designed to detect cancer and noncancerous health conditions in their early stages, when diseases are more treatable and curable.

Blood Pressure

Your pet can suffer from hypertension (high blood pressure) just like a human can.

Ultrasound

Ultrasounds are a safe, non-invasive, and painless procedure done to aid in making a proper diagnosis of a disease-causing illness or other condition.
