Chemistry profile and complete blood count (CBC)

A comprehensive blood chemistry profile, including SDMA, provides information about your cat's kidneys, liver, and pancreas, as well as other functions of the body, such as blood sugar and hydration. A CBC can identify infection, inflammation, and anemia.

Infectious disease screening

This screening indicates whether your cat has been infected with feline leukemia virus (FeLV) and feline immunodeficiency virus (FIV)—the most common infectious diseases in cats. It also indicates exposure to heartworm.

Fecal test

This test checks for intestinal parasites that may live in your cat's gastrointestinal tract. Since they are usually hidden from view, the only way to detect and identify most intestinal parasites is by doing a fecal test.

Thyroid function test

A thyroid function test detects whether or not your cat's thyroid gland is functioning properly. Thyroid disease is very common in older cats.

Complete urinalysis

This analysis assesses the overall health of your cat's urinary tract, including the kidneys and bladder. It identifies infection or inflammation in the urinary tract.
